EXTENSION OF PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL DEADLINE

The Town grants a proposal submittal extension. The revised proposal submittal due date is **November 21, 2016 by 4:00 p.m.** Please note that the interview date has been tentatively scheduled for December 15, 2016.

ADDITIONAL CLARIFICATION ON DISPOSAL OF RESIDUAL WASTE

The Town is still examining where residual waste from processing of Generic Recyclables and Source Separated Recyclables is to be delivered.

In Addendum No. 6, the Town indicated that it was not requiring but encouraged the delivery of residual waste from Generic Recyclables or Source Separated Recyclables to County Facilities. However, this issue has not been resolved and discussions are continuing between the Town and Republic Services, Inc. Therefore, the Town is requiring, for purposes of submitting a proposal, Proposers to assume that residual waste resulting from processing of Generic Recyclables and Separated Recyclables is to be disposed at the Central Landfill, operated by Republic Services, Inc. The Town is also requesting that Proposers provide a price differential, expressed in the percentage that would be applied to Service Recipient Rates, and the processing facility to be used, in the event that residual waste is NOT required to be disposed at the Central Landfill. Please note that if Proposers have any agreements with Republic Services, Inc. for the disposal of residual waste from processing Source Separated Recyclables or Generic Recyclables, this must be indicated, and that any such Proposer will be delivering residual waste from processing Source Separated Recyclables or Generic Recyclables at the Central Landfill.

CLARIFICATION ON DISPOSAL GATE RATES

In Addendum No. 6, the Amended Exhibit S, the Gate Rate was provided **as an example**. Please note that the values provided for the Gate Rate in Addendum No. 6 are **not current rates**. In addition, there may be an increase to the Gate Rate on April 1, 2017. In this event, the selected Contractor's Service Recipient rates will be adjusted in a manner to fully recover the increase price, prior to the start of collection services.
