

RESOLUTION NO. 2121-07

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE WINDSOR
CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, THE OLD DOWNTOWN WINDSOR BUSINESS
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, AND TOWN GREEN VILLAGE, LP AND
AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE IT
ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN**

WHEREAS, with a goal of developing and maintaining a vibrant downtown, last March the Town Manager's Office began facilitating a series of meetings between Old Downtown Windsor Business Improvement District ("BID"), the Windsor Chamber of Commerce ("Chamber"), and Town Green Village, LP ("TGV"); and

WHEREAS, over the past five months, these organizations have explored opportunities, such as sharing resources, to work together to benefit the business community; and

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding states what each organization will do prior to December 31, 2007 to advance the goal of sharing resources to develop a vibrant downtown; and

WHEREAS, the organizations have identified the goal of developing a plan by November 15, 2007 for a fully integrated business advocacy organization with options for cooperative funding.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor approves a Memorandum of Understanding with the Windsor Chamber of Commerce, the Old Downtown Windsor Business Improvement District, and Town Green Village, that states what each organization will do prior to December 31, 2007 to advance the goal of sharing resources to develop a vibrant downtown and authorizes the Town Manager to execute the agreement on behalf of the Town.
