The Town of Windsor’s popular *Summer Nights on the Green* series takes off at 5:00 pm, Thursday, June 17th, on Windsor Town Green with children and family lawn games conducted by the Town’s recreation staff and the opening of *Windsor Farmers “Thursday Night” Market*.
