

RESOLUTION NO. 2991-13

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
APPROVING THE NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT
AND CALMING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Town regularly receives requests from residents about traffic concerns regarding speeding, high volumes and cut-through traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department in collaboration with the Police Department developed the Neighborhood Traffic Management and Calming Program which outlines a process to address resident traffic concerns; and

WHEREAS, the steps outlined in the Neighborhood Traffic Management and Calming Program are typical of those found in many jurisdictions and are currently being followed by the Public Works staff and the Police Department in dealing with neighborhood traffic issues; and

WHEREAS, the program was developed to assist in the decision making process to address concerns on neighborhood streets and provides a four-tiered approach starting with least restrictive and lower cost measures, working upward to much higher cost and potentially more restrictive solutions.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby adopts the Neighborhood Traffic Management and Calming Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Neighborhood Traffic Management and Calming Program shall become effective upon approval of this resolution.


