

Instructions for Using the Town of Windsor Interactive Map Tool

The Town of Windsor has provided this interactive map to help you explore the population of the town in the geographic units the maps will be drawn with (census blocks). Using this map, you will also be able to see Community of Interest (COI) testimony that has been submitted, and eventually street-level detail of draft map(s) of the Town's Council districts.

How to Use the Map

- Navigate to the map's site

- The Census Block and Census Block Groups within Windsor will appear on the map. There are multiple Census Blocks inside each Census Block Group. The Census Blocks are outlined in blue, and the Block Groups are outlined in green. This is reflected in the *Layers* menu on the left-hand side of the screen.
- Zoom into an area you are interested in and the Census Block population counts will appear on the map. Census Blocks are the units of geography that will be used to construct the maps.
- Click on an area on the map. An informational box will pop up. That box will tell you the ID number of the Block Group you clicked on, as well as the population count for that Block Group. Use the drop-down menu in that box or click the right arrow in the box to view the ID number and population count for the Census Block that you clicked on.

For your reference, there are other layers available on this map as well - for example, General Plan, Zoning and Parcel layers. ***These are only for reference and will not necessarily be considered in drawing the district maps as they are not part of Windsor Town Council's districting criteria.*** They may be useful to help visualize a location, however they will not be directly used in creating the District Maps.

When we have received public input, we will digitize the Community of Interest (COI) testimony and make these layers available for viewing on this map.

How to View the COI Layers

- Click on the "plus" symbol next to the layer titled "Community of Interest Input" from the *Layers* menu on the left side of the screen. A list of COI's will appear.
- Check the box next to the name of the COI you'd like to see. The COI will appear on the map.
- Uncheck the box next to the COI name and the layer will disappear.
- Multiple layers can be viewed on the map simultaneously.

The Council's Draft Map(s) will also be available for viewing through the Interactive Map as soon as possible following the hearing on February 13, 2019.
