

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-229

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
AMENDING TITLE IV ARTICLE 5 SECTION 6 OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
PERTAINING TO COMMERCIAL VEHICLE
PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON PUBLIC STREETS**

**THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Title 4 Chapter 5 Article 6 Section 4-5-600 of the Town Code (Ordinance No. 92-20 part) is amended to read as follows:

Article 6. Prohibiting Parking of Certain Commercial Vehicles on Public Streets

4-5-600 Commercial Vehicles Over Specified Length or Height Prohibited.

No person who owns or has possession, custody or control of any commercial vehicle measuring more than twenty (20') feet in length or eight (8') feet in height shall park or leave standing such vehicle to be parked on any public street, thoroughfare, sidewalk or other public way more than five consecutive hours, except:


- (A) While loading or unloading property, and time in addition to such five-hour period as is necessary to complete such work;
- (B) When such vehicle is parked in connection with, and in aid of, the performance of a service to or on a property in the block in which such vehicle is parked, and time in addition to such five-hour period is necessary to complete such service.

The Public Works Director is authorized to install and maintain signs in conformance with this section.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take affect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage. The Town Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published or be posted in at least three (3) public places in Town in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code of the State of California.
