**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
APPROVING A SIDE LETTER AGREEMENT EXTENDING AND AMENDING THE
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
AND THE TOWN OF WINDSOR MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES GROUP
ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND WORKING CONDITIONS, AND
EXTENDING THE MOUTHTHROUGH JUNE 30, 2022**

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor ("the Town") has recognized the Town of Windsor Management Employees Group (hereafter "MEG") as the exclusive representative of certain employment classifications in the Town of Windsor; and

WHEREAS, the Town's representatives met and conferred in good faith with MEG representatives for the purpose of negotiating an extension and amendment of the MOU, applicable to employment classes represented by MEG; and

WHEREAS, the Town's representatives reached a tentative agreement with MEG on an extension and amendment of the MOU through June 30, 2022, and the tentative agreement has been ratified by the MEG membership and Town Manager; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the agreement are contained in a Side Letter agreement, which is subject to approval by the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Side Letter agreement meets with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby approves the binding Side Letter agreement between the Town and MEG, as described in attached Exhibit A.

**SIDE LETTER BETWEEN TOWN OF WINDSOR AND
THE WINDSOR MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES' GROUP (MEG)**

RE: MOU EXTENSION THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022

This "Side Letter" between the Town of Windsor ("Town") and the Windsor Management Employees' Group ("MEG"), collectively referred to as "Parties," is entered into with respect to the following:

- A. WHEREAS, the Parties negotiated and entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Parties for the period from July 1, 2015 until June 30, 2018;
- B. WHEREAS, the Parties negotiated and entered into a Side Letter in 2017 to amend and extend the MOU through June 30, 2020;
- C. WHEREAS, the Parties negotiated and entered into a Side Letter in 2020 to amend and extend the MOU through June 30, 2021;
- D. WHEREAS, the Parties have met and conferred in good faith, and reached mutual agreement as described in this Side Letter.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the MOU is extended from June 30, 2021 to June 30, 2022; and
- 2. Effective July 1, 2021 the base salary for all represented classifications shall be increased by two percent (2%); and
- 3. Effective the first full pay period after Council approval of this Side Letter, every member currently employed by the Town will receive a non-pensionable lump sum payment of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500); and
- 4. The MOU is hereby amended to include the below new provision in Article 9:

9.6(m) Any other day formally recognized by the Town Council as a holiday.
- 5. Article 10.1 is hereby replaced in its entirety with the following:

10.1 Town Offices will be closed for an annual holiday break during the week of Christmas. For purposes of this section, the week of the holiday closure is the Sunday



through Saturday that includes December 25. In 2021, the closure will be December 18 through December 25.

Employees must take the holiday closure unpaid or use accrued leave (employees cannot use sick leave). Employees will receive holiday pay for any observed holidays occurring during the holiday closure week; therefore, employees need not use accrued leave for those days.

6. This Side Letter is subject to ratification by the bargaining unit represented by the Association and subsequent approval of the Town Council.
