Windsor Town Council Appoints Jon Davis as Town Manager

(Windsor, CA/USA) – August 4, 2022) – The Windsor Town Council, at their regular meeting on August 3, 2022, unanimously adopted a resolution appointing the Town’s Parks & Recreation Director Jon Davis to become Windsor’s next Town Manager. Mr. Davis will formally step into that role on August 15.

Mr. Davis will replace Mark Linder, who served as Interim Town Manager after then-Town Manager Ken MacNab retired in December 2021. The Town hired the recruitment firm WBCP Inc. to conduct a nationwide search for the next person to helm the organization’s top spot. In addition to the title of Town Manager, Mr. Davis will also be the General Manager of the Town of Windsor Water District, Executive Director of the Windsor Redevelopment Successor Agency, and Executive Director of the Windsor Joint Powers Financing Authority.

“We considered two dozen highly qualified, top-notch candidates, and it became clear that Jon was the best fit for the job,” said Windsor Mayor Sam Salmon. “Not only does he have exceptional leadership and communication skills and specialized knowledge of the Town, but he is also well-respected and appreciated among Town Staff and Town Council.”

He added: “In his role as Parks and Recreation Director, Jon established rock-solid relationships with community members, local businesses and non-profits, and the school district, as well as with the County of Sonoma and our fellow municipalities.”

Mr. Davis has 35 years of experience working with municipal government agencies and has worked for the Town of Windsor since 2003. Starting as a Recreation Program Coordinator, he steadily moved up the ranks and in 2019, he was promoted to Parks and Recreation Department Director. Mr. Davis began his career serving the City of Irvine and the City of Santa Barbara. He and his wife, Natalie, and their children, Raven and Gianna, have called Windsor home for almost 20 years.

“I’m excited to serve our community as Town Manager,” Mr. Davis said. “I’ve helped to deliver a wide variety of public programs and services to Windsor, and I want to continue the Town’s tradition of great service across all departments.”
