

**RESOLUTION NO. 2377-08**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL  
OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR ADOPTING THE APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008-09**

**WHEREAS**, the voters of the State of California in November 1979 approved Proposition 4, commonly know as the Gann Initiative; and


**WHEREAS**, the Proposition created Article XIII B of the California State Constitution placing limits on the amount of revenue which can be spent by all entities of government; and

**WHEREAS**, these limits require a municipality to determine an appropriations limit each year in accordance with a formula set forth by state law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor does hereby adjust the Town's provisional limit by the population (1.0095) and CPI (1.0429) factors for fiscal year 2007-08 to determine a limit of \$13,273,577 for fiscal year 2008-09.
