

RESOLUTION NO. 2449-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR APPROVING THE DOWNTOWN PLANNING PARKING STUDY

WHEREAS, a parking demand study was completed by Walker Parking Consultants for the Town in 2000; and

WHEREAS, the downtown has undergone significant transformation with the addition of the Intermodal Station, Town Green and Town Green Village since the original study was completed; and

WHEREAS, Staff sought to reevaluate the parking system in downtown in order to assess what impact existing, planned and projected development is likely to have on parking in downtown, plan for future development by evaluating sites for possible parking, obtain information on management and financing measures that may be of assistance as the parking system grows staff, and prepare parking management measures that can help ensure an efficient parking operation in downtown under current and future conditions; and

WHEREAS, Walker Parking Consultants provided a proposal including a scope of work and cost estimate for preparation of an updated Downtown Parking Study for the Town of Windsor; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2008, the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 2299-08 approving an agreement with Walker Parking Consultants to prepare a Downtown Parking Study in an amount not to exceed \$49,600.00 and authorized the Town Manager to execute an agreement on behalf of the Town; and

WHEREAS, Walker Parking Consultants prepared a Downtown Parking Study, the goal of which, was to prevent a parking crisis from forming without over-building parking supply; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Parking Study provides a list of recommendation and conclusions regarding parking strategies, Transportation Demand Management Measures, parking management, and traffic mitigation recommendations that are intended to maintain the quality of life for the Town's residents, property owners, merchants and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor approves the Downtown Parking Planning Study.
