

RESOLUTION NO. 2563-09

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
DECLARING THE END OF THE WATER SHORTAGE CONDITION**

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor is a retail water purveyor and Sonoma County Water Agency contractor; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2009, the Sonoma County Water Agency announced the release of a Revised Order by the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) that requires the Agency to implement a 25 percent reduction in water diversions from the Russian River to its service area effective for the period from June 15, 2009 to October 2, 2009; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2009, in response to the Revised Order from the State Water Board, the Town adopted a resolution declaring a water shortage emergency condition and began implementing Stage 2 water reduction measures, and

WHEREAS, the water shortage period extending from June 15, 2009, to October 2, 2009, has ended and the Agency and its contractors, including the Town, have collectively exceeded the 25 percent reduction goal with an overall water reduction of 30 percent below 2004 water demands.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor does hereby find, determine and declare that, in accordance with Section 1 (j) of the Town's Water Shortage Ordinance, the water shortage emergency condition declared on July 1, 2009, has ended.
