

RESOLUTION NO. 2582-09

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
APPROVING THE NAME CHANGE OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICES
DEPARTMENT TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, on April 5, 1992, the Windsor Town Council established a Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission to serve in an advisory capacity to the Town Council for the purpose of park planning and development, recreation activities, programming and leisure and community services; and

WHEREAS, in 2006 the Economic Development Community Services Department was redefined as the Community Services Department to include the Recreation Division (pre-school, sports, teens, youth, classes, special events and facility rentals), Parks and Facilities Maintenance Division, Park Development, Animal Control, Senior Center and Pool and provide staff support to the Parks and Recreation Commission and Senior Citizen Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Parks and Recreation Commission and the Community Services Department staff to change the name of the Department” to accurately reflect the services being provided while raising the Department profile and branding it as an essential service; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission and Community Services Department staff recognize the importance of communicating the vision of the Department while creating community through people, parks and programs; and

WHEREAS, the Department name change to Parks and Recreation would not only be consistent with the name of the Commission but also with the State-wide professional organization known as the “California Parks and Recreation Society.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council approves the name change of the Community Services Department to the Parks and Recreation Department.


